The following business was transacted to-wit:

CALL TO ORDER

Judge Creta Carter II called the hearing to order at 8:30 a.m.

ESTABLISH A QUORUM

Judge Carter stated a quorum is established.

**ITEM 1. TO CONDUCT PUBLIC HEARING TO DISCUSS IMPLEMENTING
PLACEMENT OF TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES IN FANNIN COUNTY, TEXAS**

Commissioner Barker stated in 2008 the code was updated requiring the County comply by the year 2015 by putting up stop and yield signs with proper reflectivity at night, with an additional 3 years to comply with other road signs; an Ordinance is required with a legal description of the placement. Commissioner Barker stated he will implement a 3-phase plan to replace signs in his precinct with 25 signs in each phase.

Judge Carter read the Introduction, Schedule and Management required for the County.

Commissioner Strong stated he planned to put up the stop signs and regulatory signs first, then the street signs.

Commissioner Whitlock stated he would replace the signs at one time. Commissioner Whitlock stated his concern over the cost.

Commissioner Barker stated the first 25 signs with posts, signs and hardware would be \$1,800; for all three phrases he projected a minimum of \$5,400.

Commissioner Whitlock stated the need for public assistance in watching for theft of the signs.

ITEM 2. NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.

Stan Barker moved to adjourn.


