## ITEM 5. DISCUSSION, CONSIDERATION AND ACTION TO APPROVE THE CITY OF RAVENNA RECEIVING MILLING MATERIAL TO REPAIR CITY ROADS - MAYOR OF RAVENNA

Claude Lewis, Mayor of Ravenna requested material. Commissioner Barker advised the City needs to present a letter to TxDot and also consult with the commissioner for his precinct.

Commissioner Whitlock stated his precinct would haul the material if approved and would assist in the process.

## ITEM 6. DISCUSSION, CONSIDERATION AND ACTION TO APPROVE PART-TIME ODYSSEY CLERK AND EVIDENCE CUSTODIAN POSITIONS – SHERIFF

Sheriff Donnie Foster stated the department currently has a Records Clerk/Evidence Custodian set for 35 hours per week; it is requested the position be split into 2- 20 hour positions.

Scott Dyer, Auditor stated it would be less expense to the County to have the 2- 20hour clerks with the new rules being implemented regarding insurance for full time employees.

Commissioner Barker moved to approve 2 part-time clerks for 20 hours each for Odyssey Records Clerk and Evidence Custodian.

# ITEM 7. DISCUSSION, CONSIDERATION AND ACTION TO APPROVE REPAIR AND/OR UPGRADE TO COURTHOUSE HVAC SYSTEM AND APPROVE FUNDING SOURCE - PURCHASING AGENT

Jill Holmes, Purchasing Agent stated to replace the thermostats with the current pneumatic system and recalibrate would be \$4,986; another option is to recalibrate the existing thermostat for \$2,534; one actuator must be replaced for \$908; to go completely automated would be \$36,562.56.

Don Henson, ACIS Automation Expert and Maintenance Contractor stated the benefit of a new system would be to cool in zones and not have to run 24/7 and may be controlled via internet connection as well as energy savings by incorporating outside air; the new thermostats would not have to be recalibrated.

Scott Dyer, Auditor stated \$40,000 is budgeted for electrical; at the projected savings it would take about 3 years to recover the costs; there are funds in the Jail Bond line item 10-409-495.

Commissioner Barker moved to approve the upgrade of the HVAC system and move \$36,562.62 from the Jail Bond to Courthouse Repair and Maintenance.
