## GENERAL ORDER REGARDING CHILD CUSTODY DISTORIES DISTORIES DESCRIPTION DESCRIPTI

Consistent with Texas Supreme Court Emergency Order dated March 24, 2020, LET BE KNOWN and IT IS ORDERED THAT all existing Trial Court Orders of the 336<sup>th</sup> District Court and the Fannin County Court at Law control when determining a person's right to possession of and access to a child in a Suit Affecting a Parent Child Relationship and that possession of and access to a child is not affected by any shelter-in-place order or other order restricting movement issued by a government entity. Parties are permitted to alter possession by agreement, in writing, if allowed by the most recent Court Order granted. Additionally, the 336<sup>th</sup> District Court and the Fannin County Court at Law may modify current orders on an emergency basis or otherwise after the hearing of a motion to modify a parent child relationship order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the District Clerk of Fannin County, Texas shall post this Order as a Standing Order in the office of the District Clerk, and shall ensure that a copy of this order is posted electronically on the District Court and County Court at Law websites and the website of Fannin County, Texas.
