Fannin County is accepting resumes for a position as a Bond Supervision Officer. This position requires a bachelor's degree in criminal justice, criminology, corrections, counseling, human services development, law, law enforcement, police science, pre-law, public administration, rehabilitative studies, social work, psychology or sociology conferred by an institution of higher education accredited by an accrediting organization by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board. One-year experience in full-time casework or counseling, bond supervision, or probation is desirable.

The Bond Officer duties include but are not limited to: supervising caseload of offenders placed on bond supervision by the courts, and monitoring compliance with court-ordered conditions of bond. This individual must be able to communicate effectively and professionally with all levels of department personnel and other criminal justice-related personnel. In addition, the officer cannot be employed as a peace officer or act as a peace officer in any capacity.

Applicant must possess a valid Texas Driver's License and proof of liability insurance. Additionally applicant must pass a drug screen and criminal background check.
