# JOB DUTIES:

- 1. Coordinates the organization and operations of the Fannin County Office of Emergency Management and the Inter-Jurisdictional Emergency Management Program for Fannin County.
- 2. Serves as the primary contact for County-wide coordination for response, resources, and information relating to emergencies and disasters.
- 3. Coordinates the processes for emergency and disaster declarations.
- 4. Works in concert with municipal elected officials to establish and maintain effective county-wide emergency preparedness programs.
- 5. Develops and maintains policies and procedures for County Government responses to emergencies and disasters.
- 6. Oversees the Emergency Operations Center, EOC) and serves as EOC Supervisor in the event of activation or drill.
- 7. Develops and maintains COOP and relocation plans for all County facilities.
- 8. Participates in the development and administration of assigned program budget.
- 9. Manages grants related to Homeland Security and Emergency Management.
- 10. Plans, conducts and evaluates emergency drills and exercises as needed.
- 11. Coordinates, educates, and trains volunteer groups such as Community Emergency Response Team, (CERT), Medical Reserve Corps, (MRC) and Skywarn per Federal and State programs.
- 12. Makes presentations regarding Fannin County's emergency preparedness and response programs.
- 13. Perform all other related duties as required.

#### **Requirements for Emergency Management Coordinator Position**

- 1. Must possess a valid Driver's License
- 2. One year of relevant experience required in emergency management or emergency/disaster response with proven ability in a position requiring the technical, planning, organizational, and communications skills necessary to accomplish the job. Some chemical/hazardous materials knowledge and experience preferred.
- 3. Must have or complete within one (1) year FEMA NIMS training ICS/IS 100, 200, 300, 400, 700, and 800 level courses.
- 4. Possession of or ability to obtain within one (1) year a technician-level amateur radio license. Knowledge of amateur radio operations.
- 5. Must have knowledge of operational procedures, emergency response protocol, and general services and activities of an emergency management program.
- 6. Must have knowledge and skill in unified incident command.
- 7. Knowledge of complex principles and practices of emergency management program development and implementation.
- 8. Knowledge of methods and techniques of emergency response as related to multi-alarm fires, severe weather, flooding, utility/power outages, evacuations, shelter operations, hazardous materials/chemical spills, and domestic terrorism are essential.
