DECLARATION OF LOCAL DISASTER

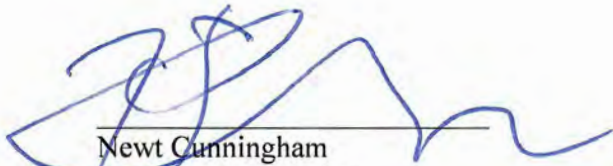
WHEREAS, the County of Fannin on the 21st day of July 2026, had suffered widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property (or there is imminent threat of same) resulting from loss of the drinking water system provided by Gober MUD, and

WHEREAS, the County Judge of Fannin County had determined that extraordinary measures needed be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property; and

WHEREAS:

1. A local state of disaster was hereby declared for Fannin County pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code on July 21, 2026,
2. Pursuant to §418.108(b) of the Government Code, the state of disaster was continued for a period of only seven days prior to the renewal by Commissioners Court.
3. Pursuant to §418.108(c) of the Government Code, the declaration of the local state of disaster was given prompt and general publicity and was filed promptly with the County Clerk.
4. Pursuant to §418.108(d) of the Government Code, the declaration of the local state of disaster on July 21, 2026 activated the Fannin County Emergency Management Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF FANNIN COUNTY, TEXAS THAT the Declaration of Disaster that was declared on July 21, 2026 for Gober MUD is hereby extended for three weeks beginning this **28th day of July, 2026**.
