Jill Holmes, Purchasing Agent stated money is available in the Repair and Maintenance fund; Fannin Ag recommends Princess Improved Turf Bermuda which is used for golf courses; the grass is not a tall grass, drought resistant and takes less mowing; the cost is \$779.50.

Richard Glaser, Criminal District Attorney stated there are typically three events in which a transcript may be needed; a presentation to the grand jury, a hung jury or in cases involving a trial with Children's Protective Services wherein the case is not tried here but is tied to a capital case that will be tried in Fannin County, the latter of which has transpired depleted the transcript line item.


